The Award:

The Visual Arts Centre of Clarington (VAC) has been shaped under the leadership of 4 Executive Directors since it's incorporation in 1976. Each past Executive Director was a champion of the arts and supported the Clarington community in their own way. The VAC celebrates the contributions of **Elfriede Haunsberger, Margaret Rodgers, Richard Toms, and James Campbell** through The Director's Bursary - a \$1000 award offered to a graduating high school student in Clarington pursuing post-secondary studies in art.

Eligibility:

Graduating Clarington high school student pursuing post-secondary level studies in art.

Selection Process:

Students will submit their application package for The Director's Bursary. The VAC's current Executive Director will lead the selection process and sit on the selection jury. The Executive Director will contact the successful applicant within a month of the application deadline. The VAC will announce the winner at the Annual Meeting of the Members on **May 15, 2019, at 7:00 pm.**

Application Requirements:

The award candidate shall submit the following to the Executive Director at director@vac.ca

- A completed application form
- A curriculum vitae
- A selection of the student's works
- A letter documenting the enrolment of the student in an art college or university
- A written statement by the student explaining their art practice (1 page, 250 words Minimum - 350 words maximum).
- A reference letter from their teacher

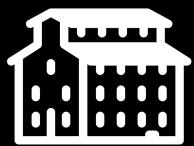
